References are usually given by **volume:page** of the PTS Pali text, eg D 3:33 or DN III 33. To find this in translation, look at **Dialogues of the Buddha** vol. III, then find the section corresponding to p. 33 of the Pali by looking for [33] in the body of the text, which indicates where the translation of p33 starts.

References are sometimes given as **sutta number.section.verse**, eg D 16.6.1, that is, Dīgha Nikāya, Sutta 16 (Mahāparinibbāna Sutta), section 6, division 1. [Note: *Verse* here refers to a short numbered division while *stanza* refers to metrical lines or poems.]

Some authors may simply refer to *the Sutta number*, eg Dīgha 12; but as the Suttas are quite long in this collection, this is not a convenient reference as you have to search the whole sutta for it.

Study sample: D 2:154 = D:RD 2:171 = D:W 269 f.

The most useful reference is: **sutta no.<section.>para / vol:page**, eg D 16.6.1/2:154 [Note the different usages of the dot and the colon.] The <pointed brackets> means an optional reference.
